How to fit the AirTouch F30i Comfort



Place the cushion under the nose and ensure it sits comfortably against the face. With the Resmed logo on the headgear facing up, pull the headgear and frame over the head.



Bring the lower headgear straps under the ears and attach the magnetic clips* to the frame. If needed, feed longer hair through the back of the headgear.



Undo the fastening tabs on the upper headgear straps and pull evenly. Repeat with the lower headgear straps.
