The AcuCare HFNC has been designed to be **light and easy to fit** on a wide range of facial profiles\*. The stretch fabric on its **dual-strap headgear** can be moved apart to loosen the fit and brought together to make it tighter. It's that simple.

As well as being **fast to fit**, the AcuCare HFNC is **designed to stay in place** once fitted. The headgear-to-frame combination stabilises the cannula and allows patients to wear it **comfortably for hours** at a time whether they are sitting upright or asleep in bed.


## Designed to last

- This durable interface can be used for up to 30 days, with fewer interface changes helping to reduce waste and save time.



# Sizing and fitting guide for AcuCare HFNC



- Use the sizing template on the packaging to determine the correct cannula size for your patient.
- Inspect the nasal cannula before use, and replace it if any parts are damaged.



- Hold the prongs away from the nose.
- Hold the bottom strap and position it at the back of the head.



- Position the top strap on the top of the
- Check that the prongs are in the nostrils, but not sealing them.
- Move the straps apart to loosen and bring them together to tighten.



• Fix the clip on the end of the short tube to your patient's garment.



· Connect the cannula to the heated humidification system tubing.
