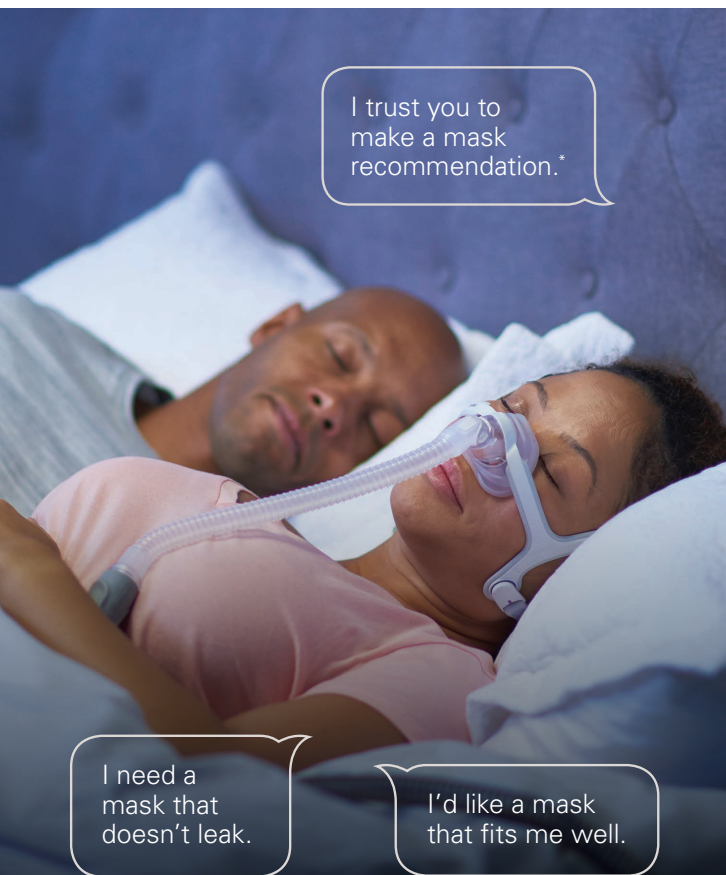

## 360° top-of-the-head connection

A tube-up design keeps tubing out of the way, while an articulated elbow enables 360° rotation for greater freedom of movement.



# Who are the active sleepers?

- They fall asleep in one position and wake up in another
- They sleep on their side and/or belly
- They twist and turn before and during sleep
- They're concerned about getting tangled in the tube and being woken during the night
