1. How many years have you had your CPAP machine for? **1** | **2** | **3** | **4** | **5** | **More than 5**
2. What is the condition of your current CPAP machine? **Excellent** | **Very Good** | **Good** | **Fair** | **Poor**
3. Recent note from a face-to-face evaluation by your physician stating that you are still using and benefit from your CPAP machine
